<p>Prison Liberation Planning Sub-group</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Support the development and implementation of local improvement actions relating to Aim 3 of the National Strategy for Community Justice ● Improve outcomes for people returning to Moray following liberation
<p>Meetings</p>	<p>Sub-groups will agree their own meeting schedule. The times, dates and venues will be scheduled by the Community Justice Coordinator and communicated to all members.</p>
<p>Reporting Arrangements</p>	<p>An action tracker will be updated and circulated to the sub group by the Community Justice Coordinator. This, along with any relevant papers, will be shared with the CJP at their quarterly meetings.</p>
<p>Terms of Reference</p>	<p>The Terms of Reference will be reviewed annually by the partnership or when changes in the Community Justice (Scotland) Act 2016, Community Justice Scotland, and National and Local policy arise.</p> <p>Date of next review: August 2024</p>
