We are here to help you settle back into the community if you are leaving prison after a short sentence or time on remand, and you are not on licence.

We will contact you before release and can support you for **up to one year after your release.**

HELP WE CAN OFFER

- Practical support to settle back into the community, such as accommodation, benefits, etc
- Support with personal and family matters
- Advice or referrals on to other services who could help such as: addictions, mental health, employment, etc
- Support to move away from offending and change your life
