

BAIL SUPERVISION IN MORAY

Bail supervision is support provided to help you stick to your bail conditions, deal with any challenges you're facing, and reduce the chance of getting into further legal challenges while your case is ongoing.

AVAILABLE IN MORAY AS PART OF A COURT-MANDATED STATUTORY ORDER

- Bail supervision is here to support you, not punish you.
- You will have a bail supervision worker (from the Justice team or Sacro) to support you.
- You will meet regularly with your worker to help you stick to your bail conditions.
- Your worker can help you access support in Moray, including housing, money, substance use, and other more.
- You are responsible for following all bail conditions set by the court.
- Missing appointments or breaking conditions may be reported to the court.
- Taking part fully can show the court you are engaging positively.

HOW BAIL SUPERVISION HELPS

- Bail supervision helps people stay in the community instead of custody, while giving support to reduce the risk of further offending - [Scottish Government](#)
